**Coast District Trustees Select Serban to head Educational Services and
Technology divisions for Multi-College District**

Dr. Andreea Serban appointed Interim Vice Chancellor of Educational Services and Technology



Costa Mesa, Cal. – At the September 21 Board meeting, the Board of Trustees appointed Dr. Andreea Serban as Interim Vice Chancellor of Educational Services and Technology for the Coast Community College District. Serban began as Vice Chancellor on *October 3, 2011*.

Andreea Serban provided leadership for Santa Barbara City College (SBCC) as Superintendent/President from 2008 to 2011. Dr. Serban was also Vice Chancellor of Technology and Learning Services at South Orange County Community College District in Mission Viejo, CA from 2006 to 2008. She joined SBCC in 1999 as its first Director of Institutional Assessment, Research and Planning followed by Associate Vice President for Information Technology, Research and Planning, a position she held until 2006.
